QUESTIONS

2. With respect to the detention extended by the Presnenskiy Court on 11 January 2010, did the applicant have at his disposal a procedure by which lawfulness of his detention could be examined and his release ordered, as required by Article 5 § 4 of the Convention?

3. With respect to the detention extended by the Presnenskiy Court on 14 May 2010, did the applicant have at his disposal a procedure by which lawfulness of his detention could be examined and his release ordered, as required by Article 5 § 4 of the Convention?
