ADDITIONAL QUESTION

Were the conditions of transport of Mr Baykov between the remand prison and the courthouse compatible with Article 3 of the Convention? In particular, the Government are requested to indicate:

- (a) How many times was he transported between the remand prison and the courthouse and on which dates?
- (b) How long was the way?
- (c) How much space was allowed for the applicant in the prison van?
- (d) Did the applicant have access to toilet during the trip?
- (e) Was drinking water available to him?
- (f) Were the transportation compartments ventilated on hot days and heated on cold days?
