The European Court of Human Rights has today elected **Síofra O'Leary** (Ireland) as its new President. Síofra O'Leary is the first female President of the European Court of Human Rights.

Síofra O'Leary succeeds Robert Spano (Iceland). She will take up office on 1 November 2022.
